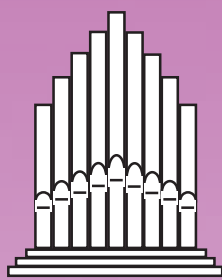

Lent is a season of preparation and repentance during which we anticipate Good Friday and Easter. Just as we carefully prepare for big events in our personal lives, Lent invites us to make our hearts ready for remembering Jesus' passion and the celebration of his resurrection. Mr. Hebble has taken six familiar hymns appropriate for the Lenten season, and wrapped them in striking musical colors and harmonies, with each setting artfully displaying this composer's highly individualistic style and craftsmanship. These three settings of very familiar hymntunes for 2 trumpets, 2 trombones, timpani and organ provide three moments of musical celebration, exultation and triumph! Level 3.

This latest duet collection from veteran arranger Lani Smith provides a valuable resource for Lent and Holy Week, with pieces suitable for offertories, communion and times of quiet reflection. It contains a mix of classic hymns, meditative spirituals and lesser-known titles that will enhance your repertoire for the weeks leading up to Easter. Lush chords and textures, plus the sensitive interplay between the instruments make these arrangements attractive and memorable. Level 1+. Two copies are required for performance.
